DETAILS:

On behalf of the Idaho-Eastern Oregon Onion Promotion Committee you are cordially invited to apply to be part of a select group of onion buyers that will participate in the VIP Onion Buyers Tour to the Idaho-Eastern Oregon Onion growing region.

The **expense-paid** tour will include stops at onion packing operations, harvest in the fields, meetings with the area sales people, and meal functions to network with many of the area's shippers and their staff. There will be considerable walking; **VIPs who apply for the tour will need to be able to walk for 30 minutes on uneven ground without assistance.** There are a variety of temperatures this time of year, cool mornings, cool evenings, and hot days. Be prepared to dress accordingly.

The VIP Tour is scheduled for October 1-3, 2026 (Thursday, Friday, with a Saturday departure, or stay at the Committee's expense until Sunday.) If you choose to arrive early or stay after the tour to conduct additional business, we will be happy to assist you in making those arrangements, but this early arrival or additional stay will be at your own expense. We hope that your schedule will allow you to apply for this tour.

Meet with Shippers, Tour Area Sheds and Growing Fields including a hosted Industry Luncheon and Dinner. *Tours will be arranged for you to see onions being harvested in the fields, to visit onion packing operations, and to meet with area shippers during your visit. All VIPs must participate in all segments of these tours as a group and no separate shipper meetings will be permitted.* **VIPs who apply for the tour will need to be able to walk for 30 minutes on uneven ground without assistance.** There are a variety of temperatures this time of year, cool mornings, cool evenings, and hot days. Be prepared to dress accordingly.

Saturday, October 3rd

Travel to Boise for airport departure home, or make arrangements for a continued stay, VIPs who stay over will have the opportunity to take a Jet Boat Tour in Hells Canyon (Hells Canyon is North America's Deepest Gorge running deeper than the Grand Canyon).
